Mayor Keeran called the meeting to order with Beech, Burton, Murphy, Scott, & Spain answering roll call.

The April meeting minutes were read and adjusted then approved. Bills were presented and approved.

Mayor Keeran informed Council that five bids were received for the Bridge Project and we are waiting for the Engineer.

Mayor Keeran reminded Council that four years ago the Village requested FEMA Grant Money to build a multi-purpose storm shelter building and he believes we stand to receive \$450,000 toward the building. Village share would be an additional \$150,000. Total cost for the project is \$600,000. If and when the money is granted, Council will have to discuss what to do with this building.

Administrator Yoder asked Council if they wanted RITA to subpoena residents for unpaid Village income tax and if so he needs a motion. Murphy so moved seconded by Spain, all in favor. He invited all Council members to attend the Champaign Countywide Public Communication Center's Operations Board Annual Meeting on May 19th at 7 p.m. at the Champaign County Community Center.

He asked Council for approval of the lease agreement with NEECFD, Beech made the motion seconded by Murphy all in favor. He reported the Park fence has been repaired but the light pole will be 2-3 weeks before it is completed. He informed Council the mosquito spraying will begin May 22nd.

Deputy McMahill gave the policing report for April and reported on the response to his junk vehicle letters. He will be sending additional letters out.

Patty Brown asked what does the village do with the wood?

Mayor Keeran asked to adjourn the meeting, Burton so moved. Meeting adjourned.
