Mayor Keeran called the meeting to order. Roll call was answered by Brown, Murphy, Spain, Thompson, Scott and Warner.

November minutes were read with one correction. Bills were presented and approved.

Mayor Keeran presented the temporary budget for 2011 and asked for a motion to approve. Murphy so moved, seconded by Thompson all members in favor.

Administrator Yoder under old business explained the request for removal of unpaid and/or uncollectible water & sewer bills. After some explanation and discussion, Murphy moved to remove them from the Utility billing, seconded by Scott, roll call: Brown and Thompson “NO” Murphy, Scott, Warner & Spain voting “YES”. Motion passed 4 to 2. Brown asked that a concrete policy be written regarding this type of problem in the future. Mayor Keeran said he would draft a policy stating that those accounts that have been on the books for one year and/or been sent three certified letters all of which had been returned would then be removed from the billing system provided legal cost would out weigh the original bill amount.
