Mayor Keeran called the meeting to order with Brown, Thompson, Murphy, Scott Spain, and Warner answering roll call.

March minutes were read and approved. Bills, Mayor's Court, Water & Sewer reports were presented and approved.

The Mayor asked for a motion to declaring May 1<sup>st</sup> through May 8<sup>th</sup> as "Spring Clean-Up Week". A motion by Spain to adopt Resolution 04-04-2011 as the dates for Spring Clean-Up Week, seconded by Warner all members in favor. Mayor Keeran introduced and welcomed the "Kindhearted" 4-H Club from Union County which attended the council meeting to witness parliamentary procedure. Mayor Keeran presented Sawyer Bix with a Proclamation for his Birthday.

Administrator Yoder informed Council and those present that Village employees will be flushing fire hydrants on April 11<sup>th</sup> and again on the 13<sup>th</sup>. He asked council to approve "roll-off containers" to be used for Spring Clean-Up. A motion by Murphy, seconded by Thompson all members in favor. Brown made a motion seconded by Warner to approve an additional roll-off container for recycling material during Spring Clean Up week the cost would be a \$75.00 trip charge if less than 4000lbs. All members in favor.

Murphy made a motion, seconded by Scott to approve Mosquito Spraying for 2011 this will include the bike path as well as the streets and ball park. All members in favor.

Administrator Yoder informed council on Saturday April 9<sup>th</sup> a beam from the World Trade Center will be coming through the Village and will be spending about 30 minutes for residents to see. The artifact will be placed at "Freedom Grove" in Urbana.

Deputy McNeely gave the policing report for March.

With no other business Murphy moved to adjourn, seconded by Thompson all in favor.
