Mayor Keeran called the meeting to order with Brown, Thompson, Murphy, Scott Spain and Warner answering roll call.

May minutes were read and a word was added to the following: Brown asked the Mayor if he had drawn up a written procedure for **delinquent** unpaid water bills which read as just unpaid water bills. The minutes, water & sewer bills, & Mayor's Court reports were then approved.

Fiscal Officer requested a transfer from one line item to another to correct Tyler Burden's overtime pay. Spain made the motion, seconded by Warner, all members in favor.

The mayor informed council the teeter totter and brackets were being removed from the park due to the children not taking care of things which could mean a possible accident and/or injury.

Administrator Yoder informed Council, in order to trash the old vehicle we have up for bid the Village employees would have to remove several items from it which would be more costly. Councilman Warner made a motion to contact the highest bidder to see if he is still interested in buying it, if so let him have it, if he is no longer interested consider donating it to the NECCFD, seconded by Murphy. Roll Call Warner, Spain, Scott, Murphy & Thompson voting yes, Brown voted No. Motion carried 5-1

Murphy made the motion to proceed with the RITA subpoena program seconded by Thompson all members in favor.

Spain made the motion to give the Triad Jr. Baseball \$1000.00 dollars as a donation for the fireworks, seconded by Warner all in favor.

Yoder told Council Members 13.34 Tons of trash and rubbish were removed during Spring Clean-Up Week. He also informed Council crack sealing will begin this week on Brandy Lane, Lincoln Place and Elm Streets.

Deputy Vernon gave the policing report for May.

Council President Murphy explained that a copy of an e-mail he originally sent to members of the NECCFD Bd along with council members, was later sent by postal mail to his employer with an unsigned hand written note attached saying something to the affect of "Is this what you want someone doing on your hours?" implying he was misusing his time at work to conduct village business. He asked Council to go on record supporting him, this attack was uncalled for.

Resident Connie Switts commented on the following:

- She didn't realize the town owns the Library property
- Required the village to make additions to its web-site. Yoder explained we are looking for someone to undertake regular maintenance of the site.
- Drinking water report is not always doing the same testing
- Regarding the sale of the Old Cruiser
- Ask if we had heard from our Solicitor? Mayor has a copy, she requested a copy
- Wants monthly reports e-mailed to her prior to our meeting. Mayor Keeran explained we are unable to e-mail from our UAN system.

Larry Preece, asked about amending an Ordinance to allow for "street legal" Golf Carts on the town streets, stating DeGraff and West Liberty allow them with stipulations. They must be insured, driver must be licensed and 16,turn signals, brake lights, tags and head lights. Village is to review and research other villages. Yoder stated with gas prices golf carts are becoming a "new fad". This was tabled until our next meeting.

With no other business Murphy moved to adjourn seconded by Thompson. Next regular council meeting will be held Tuesday, July 5th, 2011 at 7:00 pm.
