Mayor Keeran called the meeting to order with all council members present.

August minutes were read and approved. Bills, Mayor's Court, Water & Sewer reports were presented and approved.

Mayor Keeran introduced Shiela Hiddleston, Director Champaign County Health Department who was just checking in with us and updating us on a couple of properties the health district came out and looked at for us and she informed us of the "flu clinic" which will be here at the Municipal Building on Sept 19th from 9:00 to 11:00 am and at Cherry Arbors from 1:00 to 2:00 p.m. The cost will be \$20.00 with insurances and medicare/medicaid accepted. She also informed Council the Health Dept has a new website.

Mayor Keeran read a Proclamation, proclaiming the week of September 17th through the 23rd as "Constitution of United States" week. He also announced the North Lewisburg Bridge Festival would be holding activities on Saturday only due to the 9/11 dedication scheduled in Urbana on Sunday. The garage sales will be Friday, Saturday & Sunday.

Mayor Keeran explained the Inside Mileage and asked for a motion to accept the Budgets Commission's certification in the amount of \$23,500.00. Murphy so moved, seconded by Scott, all members in favor.

Ed Flemen & Greg Norris attended our meeting once again to answer our questions regarding Ordinance #254 Natural Gas Pipeline. The station would be located by Harding Screw Co, east of Middleburg. If the target number is reached the natural gas line is still a go.

Mayor Keeran gave the 1st reading of Ordinance #254 for the Natural Gas Pipeline.

Councilwoman Brown asked about the Catholic Church using the Library for parking. She was informed the Village has nothing to do with it, that's between the church & library.

Deputy McNeely gave the policing report for August.

Bryce Brown asked about a letter they received from the village regarding weeds on the property where they live. It was explained that a complaint was filed by a resident on Lincoln Place and when a complaint is filed with the village a standard form letter is sent.
