Mayor Keeran called the meeting to order.

Roll call was answered by Beech, Brown, Murphy, Scott, Spain & Warner. Expenses, Revenues, Mayor's Court, End of the Month & Utility reports were presented and approved. The August minutes were read and approved.

**UNDER THE MAYOR:**

Mayor Keeran ask council to accept Resolution 09-04-12 the amounts and rates as determined by the budget commission and authorizing the necessary tax levies and certifying them to the county auditor. Murphy moved to accept the Resolution, seconded by Beech all members in favor. Motion passed.

Mayor Keeran read a Proclamation declaring September 17<sup>th</sup> through the 23<sup>rd</sup> as Constitution Week. He also advised council in their packet was information on the 2012 Union County Bridge Fest, and information on the 2010-2011 State Audit Report which is available online as noted( <http://www.auditor.state.oh.us>) He announced Beggars night will be held on Wednesday, October 31<sup>st</sup> from 6-8 p.m.in conjunction with the County Mayors Association.

**UNDER THE ADMINISTRATOR:**

Administrator Yoder informed council the Village Crews will be flushing hydrants Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday September 17<sup>th</sup>, 18<sup>th</sup>, and 19<sup>th</sup> and residents could see some discolored water. Mr. Yoder reported taking five bids from area propane providers and was able to get the village's current provider, Heritage Cooperative to match the lowest bid and reduce it's per gallon bid price from \$1.45 to \$1.29. A motion to accept Heritage's bid price was made by Brown seconded by Warner all members in favor.

**UNDER POLICING:**

Deputy McMahill gave the monthly report for August and informed Council he will be leaving as daytime Deputy within a week or two he said Deputy Brian Dixon would be replacing him.

**HEARING OF THE CITIZENS:**

Connie Switts asked about the December meeting location.

Mayor Keeran called for a motion to adjourn the meeting Councilman Murphy so moved, seconded by Spain, stand up vote. Meeting adjourned.
