UNDER THE ADMINISTRATOR:

Mr. Yoder asked for approval to rent dumpsters for Spring Clean Up. Murphy so moved seconded by Spain all members voting yes. He also informed Council and those present Hydrant Flushing will begin April 15th through the 17th residents may notice low pressure or discolored water due to the work.

UNDER POLICING:

Deputy Dennis Lyons gave the policing report for the month of March. Councilwoman Brown ask if she was being watched and why. He informed her "No" she was not being watched that the Village and all residents in the village are under their patrol.

RESOLUTIONS:

The Village donated approximately \$1400.00 last year.
