November minutes were read and approved. Bills, Mayor’s Court, Water & Sewer reports were presented and approved.

UNDER THE MAYOR:

Mayor Keeran read two proclamations honoring Dale and Evelyn Benedict and Richard Bishop. He presented the 2014 Budget after questions from Brown, Murphy moved to accept the budget seconded by Spain, five members voting yes Brown voting no. Motion passed 5-1.

UNDER THE ADMINISTRATOR:

The Administrator informed those present the Village Christmas Parade will be held on December 8th, line up for the parade will be at 4:30 with the parade beginning at 5:00 p.m. The parade will include Mr. & Mrs. Santa Claus, chili dump and cake walk everyone is invited to attend.

He presented the Annual Agreement with the County to provide legal counsel to indigent persons charged under Village Ordinance. A motion by Murphy seconded by Beech to accept the agreement with all members voting yes.

UNDER POLICING:

In the absence of Deputy Dixon, Deputy Lyons gave the policing report for November.

RESOLUTIONS AND ORDINANCES:

Ordinance 257: Authorizing the Issuance of \$30,000.00 of Bonds for the acquisition of an Emergency Law Enforcement Vehicle. After some discussion Spain made a motion to proceed, seconded by Scott, five members voting yes, Brown voting no.

Ordinance 258: ODOT State Route Maintenance Agreement for 245 and 559. Murphy made the motion to accept seconded by Beech, all members in favor.

UNDER CITIZENS:

Bart Stokes representing the Fire Association ask Council for approval to use Village Property to hold a Circus on May 21st, 2014 as a fund raiser for the Association. This will be a one day event with two shows. Murphy made the motion allowing the use of the park, seconded by Spain all members in favor.

With no further business Spain moved to adjourn seconded by Warner, all in favor.
