Mayor Keeran, called the meeting to order with Beech, Brown, Murphy, Spain, and Warner, answering roll call. Scott was excused.

A few minutes were given to Council members to review the reports.

Everyone joined the Mayor in the "Pledge of Allegiance".

October minutes were read and approved. Bills, Mayor's Court, Water & Sewer reports were presented and approved.

UNDER THE MAYOR:

Mayor Keeran informed Council the December meeting will be held at 6:30 p.m. with the Christmas Dinner following, he ask for a motion as to where it should be held, Murphy made A motion to hold it in the fire bay as we have in the past seconded by Spain. Motion passed with read a thank you from the United Methodist Church he also read a closing state-4-1 with Brown voting no.

UNDER THE ADMINISTRATOR:

The Administrator informed those present leaf pick-up will continue thru November 27th weather permitting. He reminded those present no sticks or rocks and leaves must be located on edge of Curb or street. He gave Council information about the Public Service Appreciation Day on Nov. 17th at 10:45 a.m. in Urbana.

UNDER POLICING: Deputy Dixon gave the policing report for October. He informed those attending about three weeks ago there was an attempted abduction of a 7year old girl with in the village and asked everyone to be on the lookout for an electric-blue pick-up with a silver tool box and GA or FL license plates.

DISCUSSIONS:

Councilwoman Brown ask if employee Burden had his license yet for water and sewer. Mr. Yoder informed her he has his water license and took his sewer test a week or so ago and we should know within a month. She asked about using Impact Fees for a percentage of the new Cruiser Mr. Yoder said yes and what Permissive Tax Money was used for Mr. Yoder told her the money was used for chipping and sealing the alleys.

The Village will consider a golf cart ordinance with the first reading scheduled for as early as January. If passed the ordinance would permit licensed golf carts within the city limits. Carts would have to be certified by the Ohio State Highway Patrol or a local sheriff. In addition they would have to be a registered motor vehicle complete with brake lights, headlights, turn signals and annual registration fees.

Discussion about the closed roads in the area resulting in hoping they will all be done and opened by the end of the year.

With no further business Murphy moved to adjourn seconded by Beech all in favor.
