Mayor Keeran, called the meeting to order with Beech, Brown, Murphy, Scott, Spain, And Warner, answering rollcall.

A few minutes were given to Council members to review the reports.

Everyone joined the Mayor in the “Pledge of Allegiance”.

August minutes were read and adjusted then approved. Bills, Mayor’s Court, Water & Sewer reports were presented and approved.

UNDER THE MAYOR:

Mayor Keeran introduced Craig Evans EMA & 9-1-1 Center Operations Board. Mr. Evans promoted voting for the New 9-1-1 Levy which will be on the ballot in November.

The Mayor also thanked the United Methodist Church for the renovations and clean-up they did at the village park.

The Mayor read a Proclamation declaring September 17th through September 23rd as “Constitution Week”.

The Mayor informed those present that Beggars’ Night will be held on Thursday October 31st. from 6-8:00 p.m. He also informed those present of the Oktoberfest, held in Urbana, will be October 6th, 2013 from 10:00 a.m. UNTIL 4:30p.m.

The Mayor read a letter from the NECCFD regarding using the Community Room as a sleep room for EMT personnel by putting their Murphy Bed in the room. Mrs. Brown moved to let them use the room, with no second to the motion, the motion died on the floor.

UNDER THE ADMINISTRATOR:

The Administrator informed those present village crew has finished crack sealing Lincoln Place and the multi use path. Hydrant flushing is scheduled for September 16th,17th,and 18th. Council was presented with two Resolutions # 09-03-13 to donate a small parcel of land for an easement to the State of Ohio for construction of an ADA compliant sidewalk ramp at the corner of the Municipal Building. Brown so moved seconded by Spain all in favor. Resolution #09-03-13A accepting the amounts and rates as determined by the Budget Commission and authorizing the necessary tax levies and certifying them to the County Auditor, Murphy so moved seconded by Brown, all in favor.

UNDER POLICING: Deputy Dixon gave the policing report for August.

UNDER CITIZENS:

Several questions were directed to Mrs. Brown regarding suing the Village.

With no further business Brown moved to adjourn seconded by Spain all in favor.
